## Notifiable Diseases Policy

### Ofsted should be informed of any cases within the setting:

- Food poisoning which affects two or more children
- Any child who has meningitis
- The outbreak on the premises of any notifiable disease.

“A notifiable disease is one identified as such in the ‘Public Health’ (control of diseases) Act 1984 or the ‘Public Health’ (infectious disease) Regulations 1988”.

- Food poisoning
